

October 2, 2012- City Council Meeting

Aldermen Present: Mary Bohannon, Jeff Hayes, David Rice, Larry Walthall, James Schmitz.

Absent: Chris Schaffer.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Jeff Hayes seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-1. Larry Walthall opposed.

Fire Dept. Issue: Due to the response from the letter sent to each volunteer fireman, there was one person removed and one person resigned.

The EEOC complaint filed by former part-time employee Humberto Mendoza, was found with no violation on the city's part.

Street Paving: A change order was addressed about the bid of \$39,600.00 for 400 ton from T-N-T Company. Last year we did a two year plan of what needed to be paved. This year more footage needed to be added. The total amount being \$52,347.24. David Rice made a motion to pay the excess street paving amount. Mary Bohannon seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Water Plant: There are problems with the computer system at the water plant and issues of the system going down. To upgrade all hardware and all software is estimated \$19,500.00 with a backup system. After discussion, David Rice made motion to pay for the software and computer from the water revenue. James Schmitz seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Project Coordinator: Tonya presented her monthly report.

Police Report: Chief Atchley presented his monthly report. New police officers Joel Harper and Chris Langston were introduced to the council. Billy discussed new police vehicles.

Superintendent Report: George presented his monthly report. The trash truck was the topic. He is searching prices of a newer trash truck and will report next month. He also discussed the topic of the water line on 217 north.

The quarterly financial report information was presented to all councilmen.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by David Rice and seconded by James Schmitz.
