

City Council Meeting

August 1, 2013

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jeff Hayes, Ronnie Roper, Jim Sargent, David Rice & James Schmitz.

The meeting was opened by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. James Schmitz seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Pinnacle View Road- for a follow up, the mayor and George had talked to Buck Buchanan and Terrell about the road. Also, Mike Moore talked with the mayor and recommended to grade with rippers so water can get through and he would stand by it.

Open Bids for sale of used 2004 Chevy vehicle. There were two bids. Tonya Sneed submitted the highest bid of \$1001.00. Mary Bohannon made motion to accept the highest bid from Tonya Sneed for the amount of \$1001.00. David Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Project Coordinator- Tonya presented her monthly report. She informed the council that Becky Robertson was hired to clean the community center and city hall as contract labor.

Mayor Hiatt, George and Tonya attended the Ministerial Alliance meeting today. We have agreed to work with them in a city wide clean up next spring.

Police Report- Police Chief Billy Atchley presented his monthly report.

Superintendents Report- George presented his monthly report. He received his HVAC inspector license. A mandatory CPR class will be given to all city employees August 13th. All city employees will be CPR certified.

Mayor Hiatt reported that Patricia Ann Rogers was hired for the Senior Citizens part time helper. He also talked about the radios are working really well. However, through the FCC and frequencies we've had to buy several new radios. The county purchased E-Dispatches. This consists of firemen having a Tap code. This code sends over the pager and through cell phones.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by Mary Bohannon and seconded by David Rice. Motion carried 6-0.

Upon review of the water adjustments for the month, David Rice made motion to accept the adjustments and Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

City Clerk, Peggy Neal, was informed by the state auditor, Gary Eveld, that the transfer of franchise tax money for the past three years had been deposited in the Street Dept. which is
