

City Council Meeting

July 11, 2013

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jeff Hayes, Jim Sargent, James Schmitz, David Rice and Ronnie Roper.

The meeting was opened by the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Mary Bohannon seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Hiatt opened the Public Hearing proposal to close Northern most alley between Hancock/Tilden Street, in the City of Charleston. No one was present to oppose the proposal. The mayor concluded the public meeting closed.

Ordinance 2013-07- An Ord. vacating alley between Hancock & Tilden Streets.

Jim Sargent made motion to introduce Ord. 2013-07. David Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0. Mayor Hiatt read the ordinance.

David Rice made motion to dispense second & third readings. Mary Bohannon seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Jim Sargent made motion to adopt Ord. 2013-07. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Steve Haney was present to discuss the Pinnacle View road. A compaction test was taken and passed above 95%. Mr. Haney received bids from three contractors. Moore Construction was the lowest bid. George talked to Mr. Buck Buchanan about the pavement at Pinnacle View. After discussion on this matter:

Jim Sargent made motion to accept the standards set forth by Buck Buchanan on the pavement at Pinnacle View in compliance on completion. James Schmitz seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Trailer Variance- A request to park a travel trailer for living quarters on No. Greenwood St. for 90 days. David Rice made motion to give the 90 days variance, then reassess if needed. Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
