

## City Council Meeting

September 12, 2013

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jeff Hayes, Jim Sargent, David Rice, James Schmitz and Ronnie Roper.

Mayor Hiatt opened the bids for the street overlay project. There were 6 bids submitted. Moore Contracting Co., Inc. was the lowest bid of \$95.00 per ton for 400 tons, plus \$1,800.00 mill and prep charge. Jim Sargent made motion to accept the low bid of Moore Contracting for \$95.00 per ton plus mill and prep charge. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Tommy Qualls was present requesting permission for an extension of 90 additional days to live in his travel trailer on So. Adams & Prince St. Jim Sargent made motion to grant Mr. Qualls extension of 90 days. Mary Bohannon seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Pinnacle View Replat- Steve Haney was present to request a replat of Pinnacle View. The cul-de-sac streets will be removed and make private easements. Jim Sargent made motion to replat Pinnacle View. David Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Sewer Plant Issues- The small pond at the sewer plant is full and will need cleaning. George has a verbal estimate of \$50,000.00. The pond hasn't been cleaned for approximately 20 years. The mayor says the Branch Water money can be used for this project.

Proj.Coordinator- Tonya presented her monthly report. She will advertise for the sidewalks & lighting project. She is taking applications for the city hall/community center cleaning position again.

Mayor Hiatt reported that all city employees are CPR qualified. He is looking into purchasing an AED for City Hall.

Police Report- Chief Atchley presented his monthly report. The officers are working hard about grown up lawns & brush.

Superintendent Report- George presented his monthly report. He reported that Norman is still out due to illness. Bob McCoy has been helping out driving the trash truck.

Jim Sargent inquired about the timing of the stop light.

Upon review of the water adjustments for the month, David Rice made motion to accept the adjustments and Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

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All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by Mary Bohannon and seconded by David Rice. Motion carried 6-0.
