

## City Council Meeting

August 7, 2014

Aldermen Present: Mary Bohannon, Ronnie Roper, David Rice, Jeff Hayes and Jim Sargent. Absent: James Schmitz.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Sidewalk Project- Mayor Hiatt gave an update on the sidewalk project. It is a 60 day contract. There was a minor change order. They did not put new concrete in front of the courthouse because there was nothing wrong with what was there. There will be two street lights put in on the courthouse side of So. Hancock.

Mayor Hiatt has signed off for a Walmart Express to be built in Charleston.

Police Report- Billy Atchley presented his monthly report. He stated Leslie Asbury III was hired on July 21<sup>st</sup> as a police officer. He will begin the Police Academy on August 25<sup>th</sup>.

Project Coordinator- Tonya presented her monthly report. The bridge on Chaffee Rd. and culverts may need to be replaced. She is working with the Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Superintendent Report- George presented his monthly report. A new mower was discussed. It was figured approximately 50 acres is being mowed for the city during a season. George is also looking into changing dumpster companies.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by Mary Bohannon and seconded by David Rice. Motion carried 5-0.
