City Council Meeting

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jeff Hayes, Jim Sargent, James Schmitz, Ronnie Roper and David Rice.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

**Street Dept. Asphalt**- The council discussed streets to be asphalted. Approximately 440 tons is the bid for this year. Jim Sargent made motion to advertise for asphalt. David Rice 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

**Dress Code**-The mayor met with UniFirst Uniforms and Services and reported to the council several different ideas about uniforms for the employees. After discussion about different proposals, the mayor will have more information next month.

**Ordinance 2015-04** – Ordinance Setting Forth Requirements of Human Occupancy of Structures within the City of Charleston. Jim Sargent made motion to introduce Ord.2015-04. Mary Bohannon seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0. Mayor Hiatt read the Ordinance.

Jim Sargent made motion to dispense the second and third readings. James Schmitz seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

David Rice made motion to adopt Ord.2015-04. Jeff Hayes seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mary Bohannon inquired about an update from a house on No. Greenwood Street being unsafe. George will follow through with this and report next month.

**Police Report**- In the absence of Chief Atchley, Paul Clifford presented the monthly police report.

**Superintendent Report**- George presented his monthly report. He addressed the water lines replacement on Hwy 217 North. He will measure the footage for replacement.

**Proj.Coordinator Report**- Tonya presented her monthly report. She mentioned an update from Area Agency on Aging for months January through June.

All councilmen received the Arkansas Legislative Audit for 2013. It was reviewed for discussion and concerns. Jim Sargent commented with "Good Job". Mary Bohannon commented "the corrections were made and let it stand as is." No other comments made.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by David Rice and seconded by James Schmitz. Motion carried 6-0.

Upon review of the water adjustments for the month of July, James Schmitz made motion to accept the adjustments and Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
