

City Council Meeting

June 4, 2015

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, Jim Sargent, Jeff Hayes, David Rice, James Schmitz, & Ronnie Roper.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

James Schmitz made motion to accept the minutes and Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Fred Schaffer, representing Greenhurst, has requested money toward the July 4th fireworks celebration. After discussion, Mary Bohannon made motion to give the same amount as last year which was \$3,000.00. David Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mr. Jordan Branson and Chris Croff were present regarding property on Hwy 217. Mr. Branson proposed his plan of building duplexes on land he may purchase. His question was whether the city would allow him water and sewer since it is outside the city limits. There was considerable discussion about the sewer situation and plans for the future. Several options were discussed, along with annexing. Jim Sargent made motion to allow 6 (six) duplexes to be built and tied on to the sewer system, all of which is contingent upon annexation of that property. Jeff Hayes seconded the motion. Motion carried with ALL voting YEA. 6-0.

Jeff Stubblefield contacted the mayor about paving the entrance to City Park off School Street. The parking lot will be paid out of General funds and the school will pay half. The mayor will get a cost figure.

Superintendent Report-George was absent. The Street paving schedule will be discussed next month.

The mayor told the council that two job vacancies are available. Charlie Hice has taken another position and Larry Harris is retiring July 10th. He may move employees to other positions or hire new employees.

Proj. Coordinator Report- Tonya gave her monthly report.

Janie Karns is on vacation this week, so the water write offs report for June and July will be at the next month council meeting.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by David Rice and seconded by Mary Bohannon. Motion carried 6-0.

James Schmitz made motion to adjourn. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
