City Council Meeting

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, David Rice, Jeff Hayes, Jim Sargent, James Schmitz & Ronnie Roper.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silence.

David Rice made motion to accept the minutes. Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Mr. Jim Gattis was present to discuss the intersection at North School St. and Fifth St. He is concerned of this being a safety problem. He had an engineer look at the problem and has a proposal for fixing the culvert. After considerable discussion, Mayor Hiatt told Mr. Gattis that the city will look at the issue more.

Mr. Eric Dempsey was on the agenda to discuss ball field rental times, but did not attend the meeting.

Property/Casualty Insurance- due to unforeseen circumstances, and the insurance being due, Jim Sargent made motion to approve the insurance with Arkansas Valley in the amount of \$ 10,899.00. David Rice seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

Superintendent report- George discussed that due to several line blockages, the backwash hood out of the traveling bridge filter at the sewer plant was not performing properly and had to be pulled. He is researching a new one or build a fabricated one. Also, he discussed scheduling to clean the water tower by E.J. Neissl's.

Proj.Coord. Report- Tonya discussed her monthly report.

All invoices for the previous month of City General and Water/Sewer O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by Mary Bohannon and seconded by David Rice. Motion carried 6-0.

Upon review of the water adjustments for the month, David Rice made motion to accept the adjustments and Ronnie Roper seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

The council went into executive session, to discuss an employee issue.
