

City Council Meeting

July 7, 2016

Aldermen present: Mary Bohannon, James Schmitz, Jim Sargent, David Rice, and Ronnie Roper. Absent: Jeff Hayes.

The mayor and George met with school officials and construction workers about the issue of water going over the road at the Elementary. The mayor was informed the issue has been resolved.

There was discussion about the retainer wall on Canary St. George figured the cost to be approximately \$12,280.00. In talking, culverts were mentioned instead, for a cost of approximately \$7876.00. After discussion, the cheaper will be considered.

George Talkington has resigned as City Superintendent. He will help find a new person to take his position. The mayor is interviewing employees within the city.

The council decided on \$50.00 for petty cash from City General, \$100.00 change for the Water Dept. and \$100.00 change for Police Bond & Fines. Jim Sargent made the motion to use this amount, with James Schmitz seconding the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

The city received Raymond James shares in the amount of \$7,486.49 to be transferred to the Charleston Animal Shelter for 2016 operation and compensation. Jim Sargent made motion to transfer the money to the Animal Shelter. James Schmitz seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Peggy Neal, City Clerk, notified the council that (8) SCBAS with carrying cases were removed from the Fire Dept. Inventory, since each item did not exceed the \$20,000.00 limit. They were bought in July 2008, ck#5642.


Tonya reported the city has finished flushing the water lines. She informed the council that she passed the Water Treatment test. She also discussed equipment items that are in need at the water plant.

Police Chief Billy Atchley presented his monthly report to the council. He mentioned Brandon Hendrix will graduate from the police academy the first week in August.

All invoices for the previous month of June 2016 of the City General and Water O & M and W/S Revenue accounts were presented to the council for review and discussion. After review, all paid invoices were approved by Mary Bohannon and seconded by David Rice. Motion carried 5-0.

Upon review of the water adjustments for the month of June 2016, David Rice made motion to accept the adjustments and Jim Sargent seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
